The key services are tailored to support families and children, including family workshops, parenting sessions, crisis management, and more.

We actively engage with schools and local organizations to promote awareness and connect families with crucial resources. Exciting Future Initiatives for PEI Program

Looking ahead, our PEI program is gearing up for transformative initiatives to enhance our services and outreach further. A significant upcoming project involves a collaborative effort with the Behavioral Health Service Department (BHSD) and Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) to expand early screening and detection of anxiety in children. This initiative responds to the U.S. Preventative Services Task Force's recommendation to screen children ages 8 and older for anxiety.

How can you support or get involved with PEI?

Readers can support the program by lobbying and voting for preventive mental health services in schools funded by BHSD and MHSA, making donations to engage youth in programming (e.g. art supplies, fidgets, notebooks, gift cards), and getting involved with local schools.
